What Is The OEI?

- Governor's proposal for increasing access and success through online instruction
- \$56.9 million over 55 months
- CCCCO released as a competitive *application*
- Comprehensive program for supporting online instruction focused on the ADT
- Integrate with Common Assessment and Ed Planning grants

Main Components

- Establish a consortium and governance model
- Support associate degree for transfer online
- Support other degree applicable courses
- Support basic skills instruction
- Improve retention and success in online courses/programs
- Facilitate credit by exam

Main Components

- Provide professional development
- Develop student support tools
- Provide robust reporting and analytics
- Ensure accessibility of courses and services
- Improve the overall student experience

- Task Force or Work Group
 - Specialized skill teams
 - Short term commitment
 - Project/product focused
- Online Consortium
 - Colleges interested in forging new paths
 - Develop consortium bylaws
 - Advocate for policy/regulation changes

Timeline

- BoG approved award on November 12
- December (grant commences on December 1)
 - Launch team in place and has begun working
- January
 - Town hall meetings
 - Finalize governance structure
 - Recruit steering committee members

Timeline

- February
 - Recruitment of permanent staff
 - Commence environmental scans
- March
 - Steering committee begins meeting
 - Finalize spring/summer/fall plans
- April
 - Conduct “discovery sessions”
 - Establish initial group of colleges for consortium
