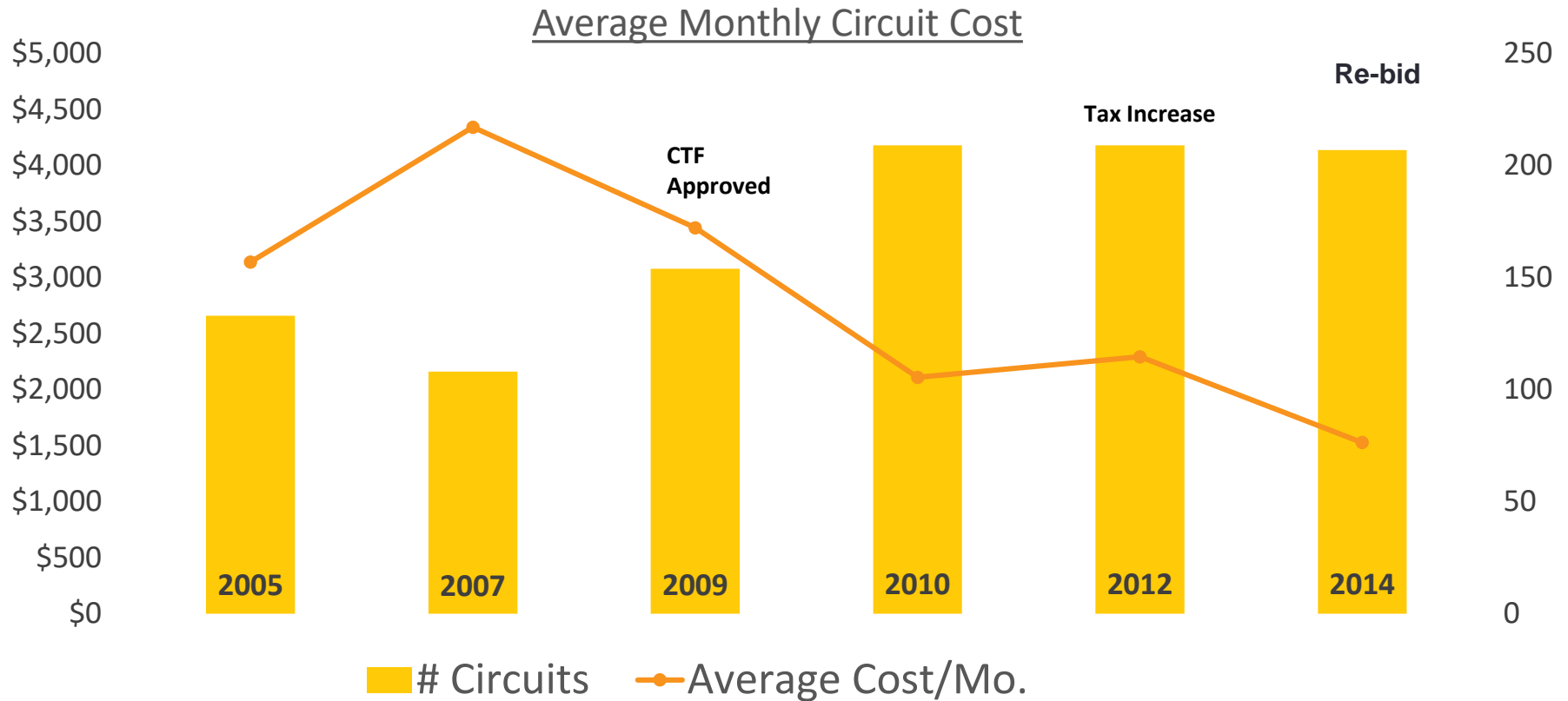

# CENIC Benefits: Cost Effective

- *CENIC = \$7-8 per mile/month*
- *Commercial Telecoms = ~\$36 per mile/month*



# Connectivity Environment and TTIP

- Equipment Replacement
  - 2014-15: \$1.4M due
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Circuits cancelled during budget crisis, not restored
- Only cost neutral or negative upgrades approved
- Central Valley Fiber Project :CVIN
  - Implementation one year latter than planned
  - Cost savings will not be realized until 2014-15
- North Fiber project, not yet approved
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Circuits (DS3), most inadequate as backups
  
- Planned BCP to Department of Finance
  - Increase bandwidth and redundancy

# TTIP Service Updates

- Video Conferencing
  - Moved from Imperial County Office of Education, \$200K to
  - 3CMediaSolutions, \$40K – 3CMeNow
- EduStream
  - As of June 30, 2014, no longer funded
  - Streaming and Storage services provided by 3CMediaSolutions
  - Transition in progress, users are coming on board
  - Cost savings in 2013-14 - \$250K
- Information Security Center
  - Developed a Board Security Policy
  - Working with the CCCLeague for approval

# CCCApply

- ***New CCCApply:***
  - *Open Source*
  - 32 number of colleges implemented
  - 50 number are in the pipeline.
- Positive feedback from students
  - Application format and support times
- Beginning 2013-14, the new version of CCCApply is available to colleges for no cost. Made possible by a partnership between Student Services and TRIS.

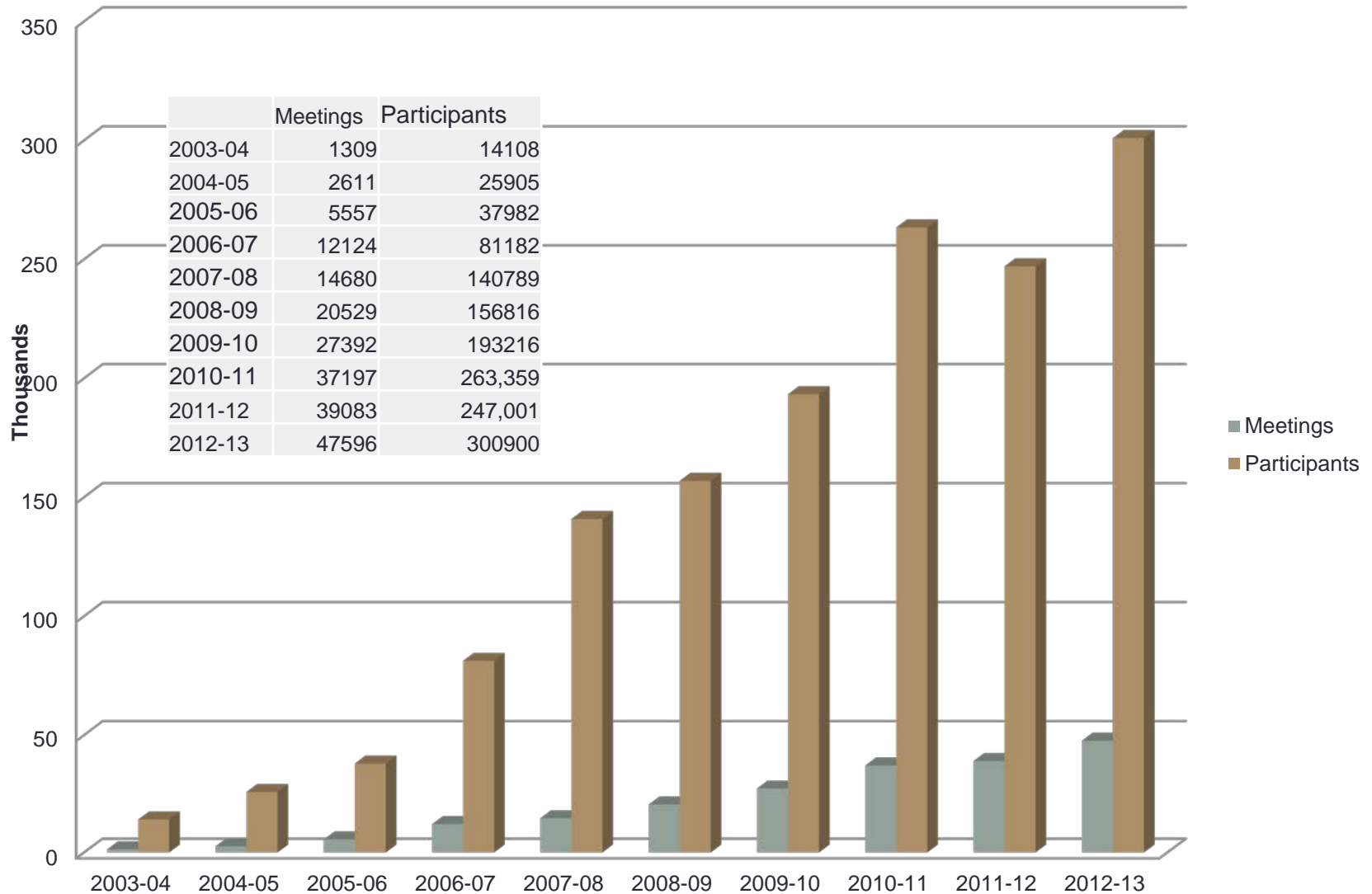
# Electronic Transcripts

- eTranscriptCA
  - 2012-2013
    - 101,891 live transcripts sent
  - 504,000 total transmittals
  - 85 institutions (CCC, CSU, UC, Privates)
- Mini-Grant
  - \$500K Legislature, \$110K CCC Tech Center funds
  - 97 Applications to implement and/or enhance electronic transcript
- CA Electronic Transcript Standard



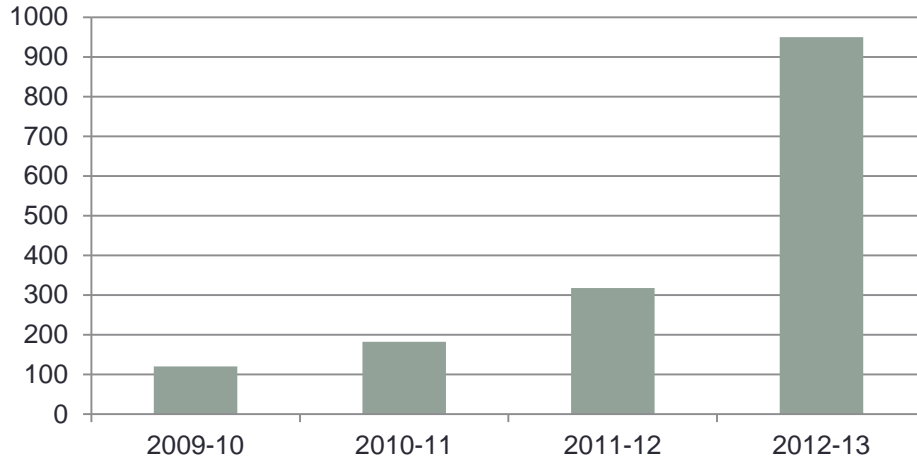

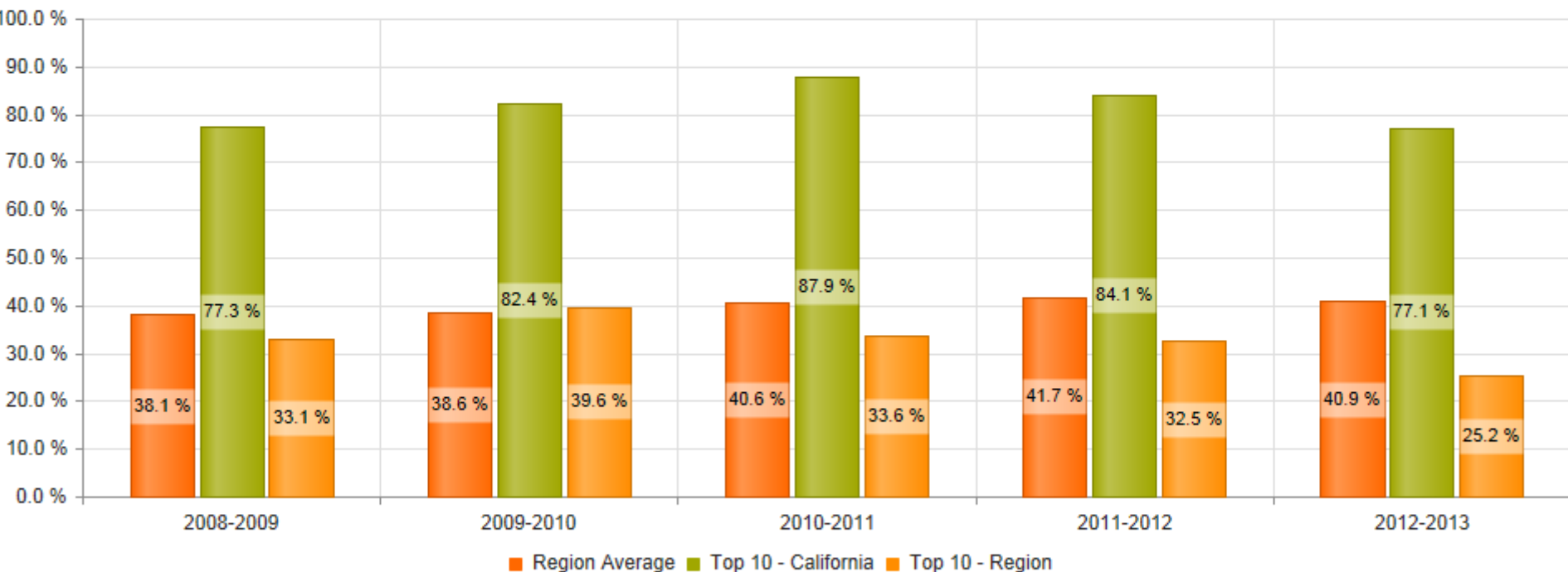
